AMALFI COAST

Overview

Amalfi Coast yacht charter is cliff-town geometry - Marina di Stabia embarkation for serious LOA, Capri Marina Grande tender culture, Positano roadsteads and NAP door-to-deck. We hold quay nights in writing because peak July-August sells out the obvious slips; the week is swim mornings and held tables, not a cruise-ship itinerary.

Amalfi Coast yacht charter - Stabia berths, Capri & Positano nights, NAP transfers and APA with Blue Ocean Club.

WHEN TO GO

Season & rhythm

- How an Amalfi week actually runs.: Stabia embark, Capri mornings, Positano light, Procida colour - short legs, held tables.
- Stabia embark: APA open, NAP transfer timed to the passerelle, Capri weather window checked.
- Cliff cadence: Capri Faraglioni swim, Positano tender, Amalfi or Ravello shore punctuation.
- Tables locked: La Sponda, Da Adolfo or Capri classics held weeks out against berth nights.
- When to take the Capri quay.: Marina Grande buys walk-ashore energy; roadsteads buy privacy and LOA flexibility.
- Capri / Amalfi nights: Confirmed quay when available - never assumed in peak.
- Positano / Li Galli: Day-hooks and quiet overnights when cliff towns densify.
- Usual play: One Capri night + Stabia bookends; tender the rest.

ON THE WATER

Cruising grounds

Capri & Faraglioni

Iconic limestone stacks, Blue Grotto mornings and Piazzetta nights.

Positano & Li Galli

Cliff-town tender drops and private-island day-anchors.

Procida & Ischia

Colourful harbours and thermal-island shore days.

Amalfi-Ravello corridor

Town quays, ceramics and hillside lunches.

QUAY NIGHTS

Marinas & berthing

Marina di Stabia

Best LOA-capable embark for Amalfi weeks - Capri in under an hour. - Max LOA ~100 m - Draft ~7 m - Gateway NAP - Transfer 35-55 min from NAP - Peak lead: 6-12 weeks peak

Porto di Capri (Marina Grande)

Capri's main harbour - tight, scenic, heavily booked. - Max LOA ~60 m - Draft ~4 m - Gateway NAP - Transfer Hydrofoil or yacht from Naples / Stabia - Peak lead: 8-16 weeks July-August

Marina di Cassano, Piano di Sorrento

Sorrento peninsula alternative when Stabia is full. - Max LOA ~40 m - Draft ~3.5 m - Gateway NAP - Transfer 50-70 min from NAP - Peak lead: 4-10 weeks peak

Marina di Procida

Procida island marina - colourful harbour for Amalfi / Capri weeks. - Max LOA ~40 m - Draft ~3.5 m - Gateway NAP - Transfer Ferry / tender from Naples bay - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

DAY WATER

Anchorage

Marina Piccola

Capri south-coast swim stop with club access.

Li Galli

Settled-weather day-anchor off the Sirenuse.

Spiaggia del Fornillo

Positano west beach tender drop.

Chiaiolella, Procida

Sheltered Procida overnight alternative.

Sant'Angelo, Ischia

South-coast Ischia hook for thermal shore calls.

SHORE TABLES

Restaurants

La Sponda, Positano

Candlelit cliff classic - hold weeks out against tender nights.

Da Adolfo, Laurito

Beach-club lunch culture south of Positano - tender access.

Il Riccio, Capri

Sea-facing Capri lunch when Marina Grande nights are held.

Lo Scoglio, Marina del Cantone

Family seaside institution - peninsula tender or road.

La Fontelina

Capri

Capri's cliffside club - reserve yacht moorings.

Lido Azzurro

Positano

Positano beach day with lounge service.

Frenchy Beach

Capri

Capri chic day-bed scene.

DOOR TO DECK**NAP to Stabia gangway.**

We choreograph Naples Airport into Marina di Stabia embarkation - chauffeur timed to the passerelle.

NAP

Primary Amalfi Coast gateway - Capri has no jet runway for charter programmes. NAP Marina di Stabia 35-55 min
Helicopter windows when confirmed Night-before hotel if late arrival

Chauffeur to quay

SUV briefed on Stabia gates and luggage - not a generic harbour drop. Marina di Stabia meeting point Capri via hydrofoil
only when yacht is elsewhere

Door-to-deck options confirmed against your embarkation slot - see embark utility below.

NUMBERS - AMALFI**Italian VAT & APA - the short version.**

Italian embarkation usually implies Italian/EU VAT treatment - confirm flag and temporary admission before contract.

Tax

Italy applies EU VAT on most commercial yacht charters embarking on the Amalfi Coast - confirm structure with yacht management.

APA

High season often 25-35% once Capri/Positano berths and fuel are honest.

Berths

Indicative marina ranges on request - draft until the agent confirms.

Capri

Capri is a core Amalfi Coast charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Marina di Stabia - Day-anchor: Marina Piccola - Table: La Sponda

Positano

Positano is a core Amalfi Coast charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Porto di Capri (Marina Grande) - Day-anchor: Li Galli - Table: Da Paolino

Procida

Procida is a core Amalfi Coast charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Marina di Cassano, Piano di Sorrento - Day-anchor: Spiaggia del Fornillo - Table: Lo Scoglio

Child destinations

- Capri - Crewed yacht charter in Capri - berths, day-anchors and shore days our captains favour inside Amalfi Coast.
- Positano - Crewed yacht charter in Positano - berths, day-anchors and shore days our captains favour inside Amalfi Coast.
- Procida - Crewed yacht charter in Procida - berths, day-anchors and shore days our captains favour inside Amalfi Coast.

BEFORE YOU FLY

FAQ

Where should we embark for Amalfi?

Marina di Stabia is the practical LOA-capable base south of Naples - Capri is under an hour. Capri Marina Grande is scenic but tight for larger LOA.

How early for Capri berths?

Peak July-August often needs 8-16 weeks for preferred slips; many programmes hold Stabia nights and Capri day-hooks.

NAP door-to-deck timing?

Typically 35-55 minutes chauffeur to Marina di Stabia - we buffer traffic and luggage to the gangway.

APA budget?

Plan 25-35% of base fee in high season once fuel, scarce berths and held cliff-town tables are honest.

Positano overnight?

Roadstead / tender culture for many LOA - we confirm holding and tender plans before you fly.

Combine with Capri and Procida?

Yes - classic Tyrrhenian loop with one or two quay nights and the rest at protected anchors.

OPERATIONAL

Mooring notes

Marina di Stabia

Best LOA-capable Amalfi embark; busy in peak Italian summer. 6-12 weeks peak; 2-4 weeks shoulder. Ferragosto densifies berths and road transfers. Primary working base - Capri day-hooks when Marina Grande is full.

Porto di Capri (Marina Grande)

Tight, scenic, heavily booked - tender culture for larger LOA. 8-16 weeks July-August. Peak July-August eliminates last-minute quay nights. Default: one confirmed night or roadstead + tender plan.

Marina di Cassano, Piano di Sorrento

Peninsula alternative when Stabia is full. 4-10 weeks peak. Summer road density on the Sorrento peninsula. Useful overflow embark - confirm LOA limits early.

Berth fees, APA budgets and event lead times are indicative and move with LOA, season and harbour policy. Blue Ocean Club confirms live figures in writing before deposit. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
