COSTA BLANCA

Overview

A Costa Blanca week succeeds on choreography: Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches nights, Alicante-Altea day-anchors (including Granadella), and APA set before deposit. Blue Ocean Club brokers the Mediterranean reality - embark via ALC / VLC, not a brochure loop.

Superyacht charter Costa Blanca - embarkation, itinerary and APA bands before contract. Blue Ocean Club brokers Mediterranean weeks.

WHEN TO GO

Season & rhythm

- How a Costa Blanca week actually runs.: A choreographed operation - Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches, tenders and tables locked before wheels-down.
- Embark ready: APA open, crew briefed, transfer timed to Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches.
- Coastal cadence: Morning toys at Cala del Portitxol, Jávea, held lunch, short reposition through Alicante-Altea, quiet overnight.
- Concierge lock: Quique Dacosta and San Juan / Alicante beach clubs confirmed weeks out.
- When to berth. When to anchor.: In Costa Blanca, quay nights buy access; hook nights buy privacy.
- Quay nights: Harbour energy at Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches, walk-ashore dinners, event visibility.
- At anchor: Cala del Portitxol, Jávea - swim platforms, quiet mornings, tender-only shore calls.
- The usual play: One or two quay nights; the rest swinging in protected water.

Marinas & berthing

Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches

Alicante city marina corridor - Costa Blanca embark. - Max LOA ~60 m - Draft ~4.5 m - Gateway ALC - Transfer 20-35 min from ALC - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

Marina Denia

Denia yacht marina - Ibiza ferry corridor and Montgó lee. - Max LOA ~50 m - Draft ~4.5 m - Gateway ALC - Transfer 60-90 min from ALC - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

Marina Salinas / Torrevieja

Torrevieja marina complex - southern Costa Blanca base. - Max LOA ~40 m - Draft ~4.5 m - Gateway ALC - Transfer 35-55 min from ALC - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

Real Club Náutico de Valencia

RCN Valencia - America's Cup harbour heritage and city nights. - Max LOA ~80 m - Draft ~4.5 m - Gateway VLC - Transfer 20-35 min from VLC - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

Costa Blanca Hub Berths

Pillar-retained secondary berthing capacity for Costa Blanca ecosystem maps. - Max LOA ~60 m - Draft ~4.5 m - Gateway ALC - Transfer 20-35 min from ALC - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

DAY WATER

Jávea pine cove - early in peak.

Tabarca Island

Marine reserve day from Alicante - rules apply.

TRANSFERS

Airport to gangway.

We choreograph ALC / VLC arrivals into Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches transfers.

Helicopter / GA

Private hops from ALC / VLC when Costa Blanca supports coastal helipads or GA strips. ALC corridor VLC corridor

Chauffeur

SUV / S-Class briefed on Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches gates - timed to embarkation. To Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches (20-35 min from ALC) To Marina Denia (60-90 min from ALC)

Door-to-deck options are confirmed against your embarkation slot.

NUMBERS - COSTA BLANCA

VAT & APA - Costa Blanca short version.

On a Costa Blanca charter the base fee is only the starting line. Budget tax treatment and a realistic APA before you lock dates.

VAT / tax

Spanish VAT on yacht charter applies; Valencia and Alicante are common commercial embark points - confirm with broker.

APA

For Costa Blanca in high season, budget APA at roughly 25-35% of the base charter fee covering fuel, berths, food and concierge extras.

What we send PAs

A line-item estimate before deposit, then a live APA report from the captain during the week.

Alicante

Alicante is a core Costa Blanca charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches - Day-anchor: Cala del Portitxol, Jávea - Table: Quique Dacosta

Denia

Denia is a core Costa Blanca charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Marina Denia - Day-anchor: Granadella - Table: Monastrell

Torrevieja

Torrevieja is a core Costa Blanca charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Marina Salinas / Torrevieja - Day-anchor: Tabarca Island - Table: La Sucursal

Valencia

Valencia is a core Costa Blanca charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Real Club Náutico de Valencia - Day-anchor: Altea roads - Table: El Portal

- Alicante - Crewed yacht charter in Alicante - berths, day-anchors and shore days our captains favour inside Costa Blanca.
- Denia - Crewed yacht charter in Denia - berths, day-anchors and shore days our captains favour inside Costa Blanca.
- Torrevieja - Crewed yacht charter in Torrevieja - berths, day-anchors and shore days our captains favour inside Costa Blanca.

FAQ

What does it cost to charter a yacht in Costa Blanca?

What it costs to charter a yacht in Costa Blanca tracks yacht size and peak weeks. Smaller crewed sailing yachts and cats start lower; superyachts scale into six figures. APA, local tax context (Spanish VAT on yacht charter applies; Valencia and Alicante are common commercial embark points - confirm with broker.) and berthing are confirmed in writing before deposit.

Which marina should we embark from in Costa Blanca?

We match embarkation to LOA, flight into ALC / VLC, and the first night's plan - often Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches when available.

Can you charter a superyacht in Costa Blanca?

Megayacht and superyacht charter weeks in Costa Blanca need earlier berth holds than midsize yachts. Blue Ocean Club sequences quay politics with the captain before contract.

Can you arrange airport transfers into Costa Blanca?

Yes - chauffeur and helicopter where available from ALC / VLC, timed to the embarkation slot at Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches.

How does a Costa Blanca week use Alicante-Altea?

Alicante-Altea is a core Costa Blanca cruising pocket - we sequence marina nights and day-anchors so the week feels unhurried. Costa Blanca is planned as a full cruising ecosystem with embarkation, berths and day-anchors sequenced together.

When is the best time for yacht charter in Costa Blanca?

For Costa Blanca, peak demand tracks local school holidays and events. We favour shoulder windows when Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches still has LOA flexibility.

Marina Denia

We hold Marina Denia alternatives and Cala del Portitxol, Jávea fallbacks before you sign.

Marina Salinas / Torrevieja

High in peak season around Costa Blanca - broker relationships matter for larger LOA at Marina Salinas / Torrevieja. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Event or festival weeks near Costa Blanca can multiply rates and eliminate availability at Marina Salinas / Torrevieja. We hold Marina Salinas / Torrevieja alternatives and Cala del Portitxol, Jávea fallbacks before you sign.

Berth fees, APA budgets and event lead times are indicative and move with LOA, season and harbour policy. Blue Ocean Club confirms live figures in writing before deposit. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
