WHEN TO GO

Season & rhythm

- How a Fajardo week actually runs.: A choreographed operation - berths, tenders and tables locked before wheels-down.
- Embark ready: APA open, crew briefed, transfer timed to Puerto del Rey Marina.
- Local cadence: Morning toys, held lunch, short reposition around Fajardo, quiet overnight.
- Concierge lock: Restaurants and clubs confirmed weeks out - not left to chance.
- When to berth. When to anchor.: In Fajardo, quay nights buy access; hook nights buy privacy.
- Quay nights: Harbour energy around Puerto del Rey Marina, walk-ashore dinners, event visibility.
- At anchor: Swim platforms, quiet mornings, tender-only shore calls.
- The usual play: One or two quay nights; the rest swinging in protected water.

Puerto del Rey Marina - primary Fajardo yacht berthing. - Max LOA ~60 m - Draft ~4 m - Gateway SJU - Transfer 45-70 min from SJU - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

DAY WATER

Anchorage

Fajardo day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Puerto del Rey Marina.

Fajardo overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Puerto del Rey Marina is full.

Fajardo lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Puerto Rico circuit.

San Juan day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Club Náutico de San Juan.

Puerto Rico overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Caribbean.

SHORE TABLES

DAY ASHORE

Secondary shore stop when the primary club densifies.

Signature shore stop near Club Náutico de San Juan - tender access and advance booking in peak weeks.

TRANSFERS

Airport to gangway.

We choreograph SJU / BQN arrivals into Puerto del Rey Marina.

Helicopter / GA

Private hops when Fajardo supports coastal helipads or GA strips into the Caribbean gateway. SJU corridor BQN corridor

Chauffeur

SUV / S-Class briefed on Puerto del Rey Marina gates - timed to embarkation. To Puerto del Rey Marina 45-70 min from SJU

Door-to-deck options are confirmed against your embarkation slot.

NUMBERS - FAJARDO

VAT & APA - Fajardo short version.

On a Fajardo charter the base fee is only the starting line. Budget tax treatment and a realistic APA before you lock dates.

VAT / tax

US territory charter rules and sales tax context - confirm Jones Act / coastwise issues with broker for foreign-flag commercial yachts. Confirm commercial charter tax treatment and APA with the broker before deposit.

APA

For Puerto Rico in high season, budget APA at roughly 25-35% of base fee covering fuel, berths, permits and held tables - confirm against LOA and itinerary.

What we send PAs

A line-item estimate before deposit, then a live APA report from the captain during the week.

Fajardo

Fajardo is a core Puerto Rico charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Puerto del Rey Marina - Day-anchor: Vieques quiet hook - Table: Vieques Waterfront

BEFORE YOU FLY

FAQ

When is the best time for yacht charter in Fajardo?

Shoulder months in Caribbean usually balance weather and berth availability for Fajardo near Puerto del Rey Marina.

Which marina should we embark from in Fajardo?

Puerto del Rey Marina is the primary embarkation for Fajardo, with anchorage fallbacks when LOA or events block the preferred quay.

How far ahead should we book berths in Fajardo?

For peak season around Fajardo, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger yachts; shoulder season is more flexible. We open the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist.

What does APA usually cover on a Fajardo charter?

Fuel, berthing, food and beverage, and most guest concierge extras. For Fajardo we set an honest APA band before contract - not a vague percentage.

Can you arrange airport transfers into Fajardo?

Yes - chauffeur and helicopter where available from SJU / BQN, timed to the embarkation slot at Puerto del Rey Marina.

How does a Fajardo week use Fajardo embark?

Fajardo embark is a core Fajardo pocket - we sequence Puerto del Rey Marina nights and day-anchors so the week feels unhurried. Fajardo sits inside Puerto Rico as a focused stop, not a duplicate of the country hub.

OPERATIONAL

Mooring notes

Fajardo - Puerto del Rey Marina

High in peak season around Fajardo - broker relationships matter for larger LOA. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Event or festival weeks near Fajardo can multiply rates and eliminate availability. We hold Puerto del Rey Marina alternatives and anchorage fallbacks before you sign.

Berth fees, APA budgets and event lead times are indicative and move with LOA, season and harbour policy. Blue Ocean Club confirms live figures in writing before deposit. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.

ENQUIRE

Begin a conversation.

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
