Overview

Martinique yacht charter is a French Caribbean south coast operation - Marina du Marin embarkation, Le Marin & Fort-de-France nights, and door-to-deck from FDF. We hold berths and APA in writing because peak weeks sell out the obvious slips; the week is swim mornings and held tables, not a cruise-ship itinerary.

Martinique yacht charter - Marina du Marin berths, Le Marin & Fort-de-France, FDF transfers and APA with Blue Ocean Club.

WHEN TO GO

Season & rhythm

- How a Martinique week actually runs.: Marina du Marin embark, Le Marin cadence, held tables - short legs, weather honesty.
- Embark ready: APA open, transfer timed to the passerelle, weather window checked.
- Coastal cadence: Swim mornings, held lunch, short reposition, quiet overnight.
- Tables locked: Concierge restaurants confirmed weeks out against berth nights.
- When to take the quay.: In Martinique, quay nights buy access; hook nights buy privacy.
- Quay nights: Marina du Marin walk-ashore energy when held.
- At anchor: Protected day-hooks when the harbour densifies.
- Usual play: One or two quay nights; the rest swinging.

QUAY NIGHTS

Marinas & berthing

Fort-de-France yacht berths

Fort-de-France yacht berths - primary Fort-de-France yacht berthing. - Max LOA ~50 m - Draft ~4 m - Gateway FDF - Transfer 15-30 min from FDF - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

Marina du Marin

Marina du Marin - primary Le Marin yacht berthing. - Max LOA ~50 m - Draft ~4 m - Gateway FDF - Transfer Door-to-deck per marina guide - Peak lead: 6-14 weeks peak

Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access

Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access - primary Sainte-Anne yacht berthing. - Max LOA ~40 m - Draft ~4 m - Gateway FDF - Transfer Day sail from Le Marin - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

Sainte-Luce yacht access

Sainte-Luce yacht access - primary Sainte-Luce yacht berthing. - Max LOA ~35 m - Draft ~4 m - Gateway FDF - Transfer Coastal hop from Le Marin - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

Marina du Marin hub secondary

Pillar-retained Le Marin capacity beyond child ownership. - Max LOA ~50 m - Draft ~4.5 m - Gateway FDF - Transfer 40-60 min - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

DAY WATER

Anchorage

Fort-de-France day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Fort-de-France yacht berths.

Martinique overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Caribbean.

Le Marin lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Martinique circuit.

Sainte-Anne quiet hook

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

Martinique weather alternative

Captain-selected fallback when the primary plan densifies.

Walk-ashore dining near Fort-de-France yacht berths - book peak weeks ahead.

Le Marin Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day on the water around Martinique.

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights.

Sainte-Anne Waterfront

Sainte-Anne

Harbour-view restaurant our captains favour for quay nights.

Sainte-Luce Concierge Table

Held table for yacht parties - advance booking in season.

DAY ASHORE

Beach clubs

Fort-de-France Beach Club

Fort-de-France

Signature shore stop near Fort-de-France yacht berths - tender access and advance booking in peak weeks.

Le Marin Day Shore

Le Marin

Secondary shore lunch when the primary club is dense.

Martinique Sunset Deck

Fort-de-France

End-of-day shore energy before returning aboard.

DOOR TO DECK

FDF to Marina du Marin.

We choreograph gateway arrivals into embarkation - chauffeur timed to the passerelle.

FDF

Primary Martinique gateway corridor for crewed programmes. FDF corridor

Chauffeur to quay

SUV briefed on Marina du Marin gates and luggage. Marina meeting point Night-before hotel if late arrival

Door-to-deck options confirmed against your embarkation slot.

NUMBERS - MARTINIQUE

VAT & APA - Martinique short version.

On a Martinique charter the base fee is only the starting line.

VAT / tax

French Caribbean VAT/charter context - confirm with broker.

APA

APA 25-35% for fuel, Le Marin berths and held Creole tables.

What we send PAs

A line-item estimate before deposit, then a live APA report from the captain.

Sainte-Anne is a core Martinique charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Sainte-Anne / Cul-de-Sac anchoring access - Day-anchor: Le Marin lee cove - Table: Martinique Quay Classic

Sainte-Luce

Sainte-Luce is a core Martinique charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Sainte-Luce yacht access - Day-anchor: Sainte-Anne quiet hook - Table: Sainte-Anne Waterfront

- Fort-de-France - Crewed yacht charter in Fort-de-France - berths, day-anchors and shore days our captains favour inside Martinique.

BEFORE YOU FLY

FAQ

Best embarkation?

Marina du Marin is the Windward crewed hub - short hops to Sainte-Anne and Diamond Rock.

Fort-de-France nights?

Yes for capital energy; most swim weeks bookend in Le Marin.

Hurricane season?

We window winter-spring peaks and build contingency into contracts.

APA?

Plan 25-35% of base fee in high season.

St Lucia combine?

Channel crossings are classic on longer Windward programmes.

Door-to-deck from FDF?

Typically 40-60 minutes chauffeur to Marina du Marin.

OPERATIONAL

Mooring notes

Marina du Marin

High in peak season - broker relationships matter for larger LOA. 6-14 weeks peak; 2-4 weeks shoulder. Event or festival weeks near Martinique can eliminate availability. We hold Marina du Marin alternatives and anchorage fallbacks before you sign.

Berth fees, APA budgets and event lead times are indicative and move with LOA, season and harbour policy. Blue Ocean Club confirms live figures in writing before deposit. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
