Overview

Think of Ras Al Khaimah as a precision week inside Dubai & UAE: embark near Al Hamra Marina, Ras Al Khaimah, protect swim mornings at Islands off RAK, and book Garden Restaurant early. Blue Ocean Club brokers the berths and APA before contract.

WHEN TO GO

Season & rhythm

- How a Ras Al Khaimah week actually runs.: A choreographed operation - berths, tenders and tables locked before wheels-down.
- Embark ready: APA open, crew briefed, transfer timed to Al Hamra Marina, Ras Al Khaimah.
- Local cadence: Morning toys, held lunch, short reposition around Ras Al Khaimah, quiet overnight.
- Concierge lock: Restaurants and clubs confirmed weeks out - not left to chance.
- When to berth. When to anchor.: In Ras Al Khaimah, quay nights buy access; hook nights buy privacy.
- Quay nights: Harbour energy around Al Hamra Marina, Ras Al Khaimah, walk-ashore dinners, event visibility.
- At anchor: Swim platforms, quiet mornings, tender-only shore calls.
- The usual play: One or two quay nights; the rest swinging in protected water.

QUAY NIGHTS

RAK marina for quieter northern emirates weeks. - Max LOA ~50 m - Draft ~4 m - Gateway RKT - Transfer 20-35 min from RKT - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

We choreograph DXB / DWC arrivals into Al Hamra Marina, Ras Al Khaimah.

Helicopter / GA

Private hops when Ras Al Khaimah supports coastal helipads or GA strips into the Middle East gateway. DXB corridor DWC corridor AUH corridor

Chauffeur

SUV / S-Class briefed on Al Hamra Marina, Ras Al Khaimah gates - timed to embarkation. To Al Hamra Marina, Ras Al Khaimah 20-35 min from RKT

Door-to-deck options are confirmed against your embarkation slot.

NUMBERS - RAS AL KHAIMAH

VAT & APA - Ras Al Khaimah short version.

On a Ras Al Khaimah charter the base fee is only the starting line. Budget tax treatment and a realistic APA before you lock dates.

VAT / tax

UAE applies 5% VAT on most goods and services including yacht charter; marina dues and APA are additional.

APA

For Dubai & UAE in high season, budget APA at roughly 25-35% of the base charter fee covering fuel, berths, food and concierge extras.

What we send PAs

A line-item estimate before deposit, then a live APA report from the captain during the week.

Ras Al Khaimah

Ras Al Khaimah is a core Dubai & UAE charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance.

FAQ

When is the best time for yacht charter in Ras Al Khaimah?

Shoulder months usually balance weather, water and berth availability for Ras Al Khaimah. Peak midsummer adds density and premium quay pricing at Al Hamra Marina, Ras Al Khaimah.

Which marina should we embark from in Ras Al Khaimah?

Al Hamra Marina, Ras Al Khaimah is the primary embarkation for Ras Al Khaimah, with anchorage fallbacks when LOA or events block the preferred quay.

How far ahead should we book berths in Ras Al Khaimah?

For peak season around Ras Al Khaimah, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger yachts; shoulder season is more flexible. We open the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist.

What does APA usually cover on a Ras Al Khaimah charter?

Fuel, berthing, food and beverage, and most guest concierge extras. For Ras Al Khaimah we set an honest APA band before contract - not a vague percentage.

Can you arrange airport transfers into Ras Al Khaimah?

Yes - chauffeur and helicopter where available from DXB / DWC, timed to the embarkation slot at Al Hamra Marina, Ras Al Khaimah.

How does a Ras Al Khaimah week use RAK & Musandam approaches?

RAK & Musandam approaches is a core Ras Al Khaimah pocket - we sequence Al Hamra Marina, Ras Al Khaimah nights and day-anchors so the week feels unhurried. Ras Al Khaimah sits inside Dubai & UAE as a focused stop, not a duplicate of the country hub.

OPERATIONAL

Mooring notes

Ras Al Khaimah - Al Hamra Marina, Ras Al Khaimah

High in peak season around Ras Al Khaimah - broker relationships matter for larger LOA. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. Event or festival weeks near Ras Al Khaimah can multiply rates and eliminate availability. We hold Al Hamra Marina, Ras Al Khaimah alternatives and anchorage fallbacks before you sign.

Berth fees, APA budgets and event lead times are indicative and move with LOA, season and harbour policy. Blue Ocean Club confirms live figures in writing before deposit. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
