WHEN TO GO

Season & rhythm

- How a Yanbu week actually runs.: A choreographed operation - berths, tenders and tables locked before wheels-down.
- Embark ready: APA open, crew briefed, transfer timed to Yanbu yacht access.
- Local cadence: Morning toys, held lunch, short reposition around Yanbu, quiet overnight.
- Concierge lock: Restaurants and clubs confirmed weeks out - not left to chance.
- When to berth. When to anchor.: In Yanbu, quay nights buy access; hook nights buy privacy.
- Quay nights: Harbour energy around Yanbu yacht access, walk-ashore dinners, event visibility.
- At anchor: Swim platforms, quiet mornings, tender-only shore calls.
- The usual play: One or two quay nights; the rest swinging in protected water.

Deeper holding when Yanbu yacht access is full.

Weather-aware swim cove on the Saudi Red Sea circuit.

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

Jeddah day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Jeddah Yacht Club.

TRANSFERS

Airport to gangway.

We choreograph JED / NUM arrivals into Yanbu yacht access.

Helicopter / GA

Private hops when Yanbu supports coastal helipads or GA strips into the Red Sea gateway. JED corridor NUM corridor

Chauffeur

SUV / S-Class briefed on Yanbu yacht access gates - timed to embarkation. To Yanbu yacht access Coastal staging from Jeddah

Door-to-deck options are confirmed against your embarkation slot.

NUMBERS - YANBU

VAT & APA - Yanbu short version.

On a Yanbu charter the base fee is only the starting line. Budget tax treatment and a realistic APA before you lock dates.

VAT / tax

Saudi Red Sea charter permits and coastal access rules are evolving - confirm APA, crew visas and restricted zones with broker. Confirm commercial charter tax treatment and APA with the broker before deposit.

APA

For Saudi Red Sea in high season, budget APA at roughly 30-40% of base fee covering fuel, berths, permits and held tables - confirm against LOA and itinerary.

What we send PAs

A line-item estimate before deposit, then a live APA report from the captain during the week.

Yanbu

Yanbu is a core Saudi Red Sea charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Yanbu yacht access - Day-anchor: NEOM / Amaala lee cove - Table: Saudi Red Sea Quay Classic

BEFORE YOU FLY

FAQ

When is the best time for yacht charter in Yanbu?

Shoulder months in Red Sea usually balance weather and berth availability for Yanbu near Yanbu yacht access.

Which marina should we embark from in Yanbu?

Yanbu yacht access is the primary embarkation for Yanbu, with anchorage fallbacks when LOA or events block the preferred quay.

How far ahead should we book berths in Yanbu?

For peak season around Yanbu, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger yachts; shoulder season is more flexible. We open the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist.

What does APA usually cover on a Yanbu charter?

Fuel, berthing, food and beverage, and most guest concierge extras. For Yanbu we set an honest APA band before contract - not a vague percentage.

Can you arrange airport transfers into Yanbu?

Yes - chauffeur and helicopter where available from JED / NUM, timed to the embarkation slot at Yanbu yacht access.

How does a Yanbu week use Jeddah coast?

Jeddah coast is a core Yanbu pocket - we sequence Yanbu yacht access nights and day-anchors so the week feels unhurried. Yanbu sits inside Saudi Red Sea as a focused stop, not a duplicate of the country hub.

OPERATIONAL

Mooring notes

Yanbu - Yanbu yacht access

High in peak season around Yanbu - broker relationships matter for larger LOA. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Event or festival weeks near Yanbu can multiply rates and eliminate availability. We hold Yanbu yacht access alternatives and anchorage fallbacks before you sign.

Berth fees, APA budgets and event lead times are indicative and move with LOA, season and harbour policy. Blue Ocean Club confirms live figures in writing before deposit. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
