ZADAR

Overview

Think of Zadar as a precision week inside Croatia: embark near Marina Kornati Biograd, protect swim mornings at ut / Kornati channels, and book Foa early. Blue Ocean Club brokers the berths and APA before contract.

Private yacht charter in Zadar via DBV / SPU. Charter a yacht for a week - berths, day-anchors and shore days by Blue Ocean Club.

WHEN TO GO

Season & rhythm

- How a Zadar week actually runs.: A choreographed operation - berths, tenders and tables locked before wheels-down.
- Embark ready: APA open, crew briefed, transfer timed to Marina Kornati Biograd.
- Local cadence: Morning toys, held lunch, short reposition around Zadar, quiet overnight.
- Concierge lock: Restaurants and clubs confirmed weeks out - not left to chance.
- When to berth. When to anchor.: In Zadar, quay nights buy access; hook nights buy privacy.
- Quay nights: Harbour energy around Marina Kornati Biograd, walk-ashore dinners, event visibility.
- At anchor: Swim platforms, quiet mornings, tender-only shore calls.
- The usual play: One or two quay nights; the rest swinging in protected water.

Cruising grounds

Kornati & Zadar

National-park limestone labyrinth north of Zadar.

Central Dalmatia

Split-Hvar-Bra-Vis triangle - short legs and classic island overnight cadence.

QUAY NIGHTS

Marinas & berthing

Marina Kornati Biograd

Northern Dalmatia base for Kornati and Zadar loops. - Max LOA ~40 m - Draft ~4 m - Gateway ZAD - Transfer 35-50 min from ZAD - Peak lead: 4-12 weeks for peak season slips

DAY WATER

Anchorage

Telaica Park

Cliffs and salt lake - national-park rules on overnight.

ut / Kornati channels

Limestone labyrinth day-hooks - park tickets with the captain.

Ugljan east bays

Quiet overnight opposite Zadar when Biograd is full.

Stiniva Bay, Vis

Iconic cliff cove - day stop in season; arrive early.

Pakleni Islands

Day-anchors off Hvar with beach-club tender drops.

Harbour terrace by the old walls - embarkation dinner classic.

Walk-ashore Italian-Dalmatian plates near the waterfront.

Local grilled fish - quieter than the tourist strip.

Hvar Town

Fine Dalmatian seafood on the harbour - book peak weeks ahead.

Old Town walls with Adriatic views.

DAY ASHORE

Beach clubs

Kolovare Beach

Zadar

City beach morning before a Kornati departure.

Hula Hula Beach Bar

Hvar

Sunset rocks west of Hvar Town - tender VHF in season.

TRANSFERS

Airport to gangway.

We choreograph DBV / SPU arrivals into Marina Kornati Biograd.

Helicopter / GA

Private hops when Zadar supports coastal helipads or GA strips into the Mediterranean gateway. DBV corridor SPU corridor ZAD corridor

Chauffeur

SUV / S-Class briefed on Marina Kornati Biograd gates - timed to embarkation. To Marina Kornati Biograd 35-50 min from ZAD

Door-to-deck options are confirmed against your embarkation slot.

NUMBERS - ZADAR

VAT & APA - Zadar short version.

On a Zadar charter the base fee is only the starting line. Budget tax treatment and a realistic APA before you lock dates.

VAT

Croatia commonly cites a reduced rate around 13% on qualifying charter - confirm commercial structure and flag before contract.

APA

Plan 25-35% of base in high season once ACI berths, fuel and held tables are included.

Parks

Mljet / Kornati fees sit in APA - captains arrange on arrival.

Zadar

Zadar is a core Croatia charter stop - marina nights, day-anchors and shore tables we hold in advance. Berth context: Marina Kornati Biograd - Day-anchor: edro South - Table: Konoba Mate

BEFORE YOU FLY

FAQ

When is the best time for yacht charter in Zadar?

Shoulder months usually balance weather, water and berth availability for Zadar. Peak midsummer adds density and premium quay pricing at Marina Kornati Biograd.

Which marina should we embark from in Zadar?

Marina Kornati Biograd is the primary embarkation for Zadar, with anchorage fallbacks when LOA or events block the preferred quay.

How far ahead should we book berths in Zadar?

For peak season around Zadar, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger yachts; shoulder season is more flexible. We open the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist.

What does APA usually cover on a Zadar charter?

Fuel, berthing, food and beverage, and most guest concierge extras. For Zadar we set an honest APA band before contract - not a vague percentage.

Can you arrange airport transfers into Zadar?

Yes - chauffeur and helicopter where available from DBV / SPU, timed to the embarkation slot at Marina Kornati Biograd.

How does a Zadar week use Kornati & Zadar?

Kornati & Zadar is a core Zadar pocket - we sequence Marina Kornati Biograd nights and day-anchors so the week feels unhurried. Zadar sits inside Croatia as a focused stop, not a duplicate of the country hub.

OPERATIONAL

Mooring notes

Zadar - Marina Kornati Biograd

High in peak season around Zadar - broker relationships matter for larger LOA. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Event or festival weeks near Zadar can multiply rates and eliminate availability. We hold Marina Kornati Biograd alternatives and anchorage fallbacks before you sign.

Berth fees, APA budgets and event lead times are indicative and move with LOA, season and harbour policy. Blue Ocean Club confirms live figures in writing before deposit. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
