Serving as the primary Al Wakrah yacht berthing point for Al Wakrah Yacht Charter in the Middle East, Al Wakrah yacht access provides 40 berths. It accommodates vessels with an indicative maximum length overall of 40 metres and a maximum draught of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Al Wakrah yacht access with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical DOH quay timing: 40-60 min from DOH. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

TYPICAL TRANSFER	40-60 min from DOH

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Al Wakrah yacht access

Door-to-deck for Al Wakrah: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Al Wakrah yacht access - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Al Wakrah yacht access with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

DOH

Typical DOH quay: 40-60 min from DOH. Typical transfer: 40-60 min from DOH

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

SHORE TABLES

Nearby dining

Al Wakrah Harbour Table

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Al Wakrah yacht access - book peak weeks ahead.

Al Wakrah Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day around Al Wakrah in the Qatar circuit.

Al Wakrah yacht access Quay Dining

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights at Al Wakrah yacht access.

Al Wakrah Concierge Table

Held table for yacht parties - advance booking in season.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Al Wakrah day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Al Wakrah yacht access.

Al Wakrah overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Al Wakrah yacht access is full.

Al Wakrah lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Qatar circuit.

Doha day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Doha Corniche / yacht berths.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Al Wakrah high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Al Wakrah yacht access?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your DOH arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Al Wakrah yacht access?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Al Wakrah.

What does berthing cost at Al Wakrah yacht access?

Berthing at Al Wakrah yacht access is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Al Wakrah yacht access?

Yes - Al Wakrah yacht access is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Al Wakrah. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Al Wakrah yacht access?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Al Wakrah yacht access?

Typical DOH quay timing: 40-60 min from DOH. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Al Wakrah day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Al Wakrah yacht access?

Al Wakrah yacht access typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
