Overview

As the primary Wadi Rum Gate Yacht Charter berthing in the Red Sea, this Aqaba shore staging for desert days offers 10 berths. The destination accommodates yachts with an indicative maximum LOA of 30 metres and a maximum draft of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Aqaba shore staging for desert days with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical AQJ quay timing: 20-30 min from AQJ. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Aqaba shore staging for desert days

Door-to-deck for Wadi Rum Gate: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Aqaba shore staging for desert days - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Aqaba shore staging for desert days with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

AQJ

Typical AQJ quay: 20-30 min from AQJ. Typical transfer: 20-30 min from AQJ

Nearby dining

Wadi Rum Gate Harbour Table

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Aqaba shore staging for desert days - book peak weeks ahead.

Wadi Rum Gate Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day around Wadi Rum Gate in the Aqaba circuit.

Aqaba shore staging for desert days Quay Dining

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights at Aqaba shore staging for desert days.

Wadi Rum Gate Concierge Table

Held table for yacht parties - advance booking in season.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Wadi Rum Gate day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Aqaba shore staging for desert days.

Wadi Rum Gate overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Aqaba shore staging for desert days is full.

Wadi Rum Gate lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Aqaba circuit.

Aqaba day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Royal Yacht Club of Jordan.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Wadi Rum Gate high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Aqaba shore staging for desert days?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your AQJ arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Aqaba shore staging for desert days?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Wadi Rum Gate.

What does berthing cost at Aqaba shore staging for desert days?

Berthing at Aqaba shore staging for desert days is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Aqaba shore staging for desert days?

Yes - Aqaba shore staging for desert days is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Wadi Rum Gate. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Aqaba shore staging for desert days?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Aqaba shore staging for desert days?

Typical AQJ quay timing: 20-30 min from AQJ. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Wadi Rum Gate day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Aqaba shore staging for desert days?

Aqaba shore staging for desert days typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
