## Overview

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Baa Atoll resort docks - Serving as a base for a Baa Atoll Yacht Charter, these Indian Ocean resort docks offer UNESCO biosphere reserve quay access for western Maldives weeks. They accommodate yachts with an indicative maximum LOA of 50 metres and a draft of 4 metres.

## PILOTAGE NOTES

## Approach

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Approach Baa Atoll resort docks with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead.

## HOLDS &amp; LEAD TIMES

## Berthing

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Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

## TRANSFERS

## Door to deck

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Typical MLE quay timing: Seaplane / yacht run from Malé. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

## EMBARK UTILITY

## Embark at Baa Atoll resort docks

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Door-to-deck for Baa Atoll: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

| <b>MEETING POINT</b>  | Meeting point: Baa Atoll resort docks - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.                                 |
| <b>ARRIVAL BUFFER</b> | Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed. |
| <b>PEAK LEAD TIME</b> | Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.                                    |

### Captain notes

Approach Baa Atoll resort docks with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead.

### Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

### Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

### MLE

Typical MLE quay: Seaplane / yacht run from Malé. Typical transfer: Seaplane / yacht run from Malé

## TIMING

**Seasonal note**

Peak density tracks Baa Atoll high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

## INDICATIVE DRAFT

**Berth fees**

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

## BEFORE YOU FLY

**Berthing FAQ****How do I embark at Baa Atoll resort docks?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your MLE arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

**Can I berth a yacht at Baa Atoll resort docks?**

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Baa Atoll.

**What does berthing cost at Baa Atoll resort docks?**

What berthing costs at Baa Atoll resort docks depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

**Is yacht charter available from Baa Atoll resort docks?**

Private yacht charter from Baa Atoll resort docks is common for Baa Atoll weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

**How far ahead should we book a berth at Baa Atoll resort docks?**

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

**What is the practical embarkation airport for Baa Atoll resort docks?**

Typical MLE quay timing: Seaplane / yacht run from Malé. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

**Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?**

Hanifaru Bay approaches is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.





### What services should we expect at Baa Atoll resort docks?

Baa Atoll resort docks typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

*Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.*
