Overview

The Bahrain Yacht Club is the primary Manama yacht berthing location in the Middle East. Suitable for a Manama yacht charter, it offers 120 berths, accommodating vessels with an indicative maximum LOA of 50 metres and a maximum draught of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Bahrain Yacht Club with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical BAH quay timing: 25-40 min from BAH. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

TYPICAL TRANSFER	25-40 min from BAH

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Bahrain Yacht Club

Door-to-deck for Manama: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Bahrain Yacht Club - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Bahrain Yacht Club with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

BAH

Typical BAH quay: 25-40 min from BAH. Typical transfer: 25-40 min from BAH

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Nearby dining

Manama Harbour Table

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Bahrain Yacht Club - book peak weeks ahead.

Local plates after a day around Manama in the Bahrain circuit.

Bahrain Yacht Club Quay Dining

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights at Bahrain Yacht Club.

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Manama day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Bahrain Yacht Club.

Manama overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Bahrain Yacht Club is full.

Manama lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Bahrain circuit.

Bahrain overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Middle East.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Manama high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Bahrain Yacht Club?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your BAH arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Bahrain Yacht Club?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Manama.

What does berthing cost at Bahrain Yacht Club?

What berthing costs at Bahrain Yacht Club depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Bahrain Yacht Club?

Private yacht charter from Bahrain Yacht Club is common for Manama weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Bahrain Yacht Club?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Bahrain Yacht Club?

Typical BAH quay timing: 25-40 min from BAH. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Manama day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Bahrain Yacht Club?

Bahrain Yacht Club typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
