Overview

Bourail / west-coast yacht access is the primary Bourail yacht berthing in the Pacific. For a Bourail Yacht Charter, this location offers 15 berths. It accommodates vessels with an indicative maximum LOA of 35 metres and a maximum draught of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Bourail / west-coast yacht access with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical NOU quay timing: West-coast staging. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Bourail / west-coast yacht access

Door-to-deck for Bourail: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Bourail / west-coast yacht access - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Bourail / west-coast yacht access with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

NOU

Typical NOU quay: West-coast staging. Typical transfer: West-coast staging

SHORE TABLES

Nearby dining

Bourail Harbour Table

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Bourail / west-coast yacht access - book peak weeks ahead.

Bourail Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day around Bourail in the New Caledonia circuit.

Bourail / west-coast yacht access Quay Dining

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights at Bourail / west-coast yacht access.

Bourail Concierge Table

Held table for yacht parties - advance booking in season.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Bourail day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Bourail / west-coast yacht access.

Bourail overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Bourail / west-coast yacht access is full.

Bourail lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the New Caledonia circuit.

Nouméa day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Port Moselle.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Bourail high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Bourail / west-coast yacht access?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your NOU arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Bourail / west-coast yacht access?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Bourail.

What does berthing cost at Bourail / west-coast yacht access?

What berthing costs at Bourail / west-coast yacht access depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Bourail / west-coast yacht access?

Private yacht charter from Bourail / west-coast yacht access is common for Bourail weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Bourail / west-coast yacht access?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Bourail / west-coast yacht access?

Typical NOU quay timing: West-coast staging. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Bourail day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Bourail / west-coast yacht access?

Bourail / west-coast yacht access typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
