Overview

Cayo Largo del Sur marina in the Caribbean is a south-coast island marina for clear-water weeks. Suitable for a Cayo Largo Yacht Charter, this location accommodates vessels with an indicative maximum LOA of 40 m and a maximum draft of 3.5 m.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Cayo Largo del Sur marina with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical VRA quay timing: Air hop to Cayo Largo. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Cayo Largo del Sur marina

Door-to-deck for Cayo Largo: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Cayo Largo del Sur marina - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Cayo Largo del Sur marina with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

VRA

Typical VRA quay: Air hop to Cayo Largo. Typical transfer: Air hop to Cayo Largo

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Cayo Largo high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Cayo Largo del Sur marina?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your VRA arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Cayo Largo del Sur marina?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Cayo Largo.

What does berthing cost at Cayo Largo del Sur marina?

Cayo Largo del Sur marina berth fees move with demand. Blue Ocean Club holds an indicative band for your LOA and dates, then locks the written quote before APA is set for the Cayo Largo week.

Is yacht charter available from Cayo Largo del Sur marina?

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter both use Cayo Largo del Sur marina as a working berth when LOA fits. We match hull class to quay politics and your itinerary.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Cayo Largo del Sur marina?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Cayo Largo del Sur marina?

Typical VRA quay timing: Air hop to Cayo Largo. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Cayo Largo west beaches is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Cayo Largo del Sur marina?

Cayo Largo del Sur marina typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
