Serving as the primary San Juan yacht berthing location for a Caribbean yacht charter, Club Náutico de San Juan offers 100 berths. The marina accommodates vessels with an indicative maximum LOA of 50 metres and a maximum draft of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Club Náutico de San Juan with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical SJU quay timing: 20-35 min from SJU. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

TYPICAL TRANSFER	20-35 min from SJU

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Club Náutico de San Juan

Door-to-deck for San Juan: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Club Náutico de San Juan - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Club Náutico de San Juan with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

SJU

Typical SJU quay: 20-35 min from SJU. Typical transfer: 20-35 min from SJU

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

SHORE TABLES

Nearby dining

San Juan Harbour Table

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Club Náutico de San Juan - book peak weeks ahead.

San Juan Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day around San Juan in the Puerto Rico circuit.

Club Náutico de San Juan Quay Dining

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights at Club Náutico de San Juan.

Puerto Rico Quay Classic

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

San Juan day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Club Náutico de San Juan.

San Juan overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Club Náutico de San Juan is full.

San Juan lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Puerto Rico circuit.

Puerto Rico overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Caribbean.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks San Juan high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Club Náutico de San Juan?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your SJU arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Club Náutico de San Juan?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for San Juan.

What does berthing cost at Club Náutico de San Juan?

Club Náutico de San Juan berth fees move with demand. Blue Ocean Club holds an indicative band for your LOA and dates, then locks the written quote before APA is set for the San Juan week.

Is yacht charter available from Club Náutico de San Juan?

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter both use Club Náutico de San Juan as a working berth when LOA fits. We match hull class to quay politics and your itinerary.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Club Náutico de San Juan?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Club Náutico de San Juan?

Typical SJU quay timing: 20-35 min from SJU. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

San Juan day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Club Náutico de San Juan?

Club Náutico de San Juan typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.

ENQUIRE

Begin a conversation.

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
