Overview

Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths in the Americas offers 40 berths for Costa Rica Pacific Yacht Charter. With an indicative maximum LOA of 50 m and draught of 4 m, it provides pillar-retained secondary berthing capacity for Costa Rica Pacific ecosystem maps.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical XQP quay timing: 10-20 min from XQP / 3h from SJO. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths

Door-to-deck for Costa Rica Pacific: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

XQP

Typical XQP quay: 10-20 min from XQP / 3h from SJO. Typical transfer: 10-20 min from XQP / 3h from SJO

Quepos Harbour Table

Walk-ashore dining near Marina Pez Vela - book peak weeks ahead.

Golfito Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day on the water around Costa Rica Pacific.

Costa Rica Pacific Quay Classic

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights.

Papagayo Waterfront

Harbour-view restaurant our captains favour for quay nights.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Quepos day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Marina Pez Vela.

Costa Rica Pacific overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Americas.

Golfito lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Costa Rica Pacific circuit.

Papagayo quiet hook

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Costa Rica Pacific high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your XQP arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Costa Rica Pacific.

What does berthing cost at Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths?

What berthing costs at Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths?

Private yacht charter from Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths is common for Costa Rica Pacific weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths?

Typical XQP quay timing: 10-20 min from XQP / 3h from SJO. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Quepos day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths?

Costa Rica Pacific Hub Berths typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
