Overview

Retained as an Ionian pillar secondary while the primary Corfu child stays under Greece, D-Marin Gouvia in the Mediterranean provides a sheltered harbour basin. The marina has 1,1200 berths for yachts with an indicative maximum LOA of 80 metres and a draft of 4.5 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach D-Marin Gouvia (Ionian secondary) with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical CFU quay timing: 15-25 min from CFU. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

AIRPORT CFU

TYPICAL TRANSFER 15-25 min from CFU

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at D-Marin Gouvia (Ionian secondary)

Door-to-deck for Ionian Islands: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: D-Marin Gouvia (Ionian secondary) - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach D-Marin Gouvia (Ionian secondary) with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

CFU

Typical CFU quay: 15-25 min from CFU. Typical transfer: 15-25 min from CFU

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Porto Spilia, Meganisi

Tree-lined overnight favourite with tavernas ashore.

Fiskardo approaches

Day call toward Kefalonia when the Ionian week stretches south.

One Tree Bay / Abelike

Meganisi swim pockets near Lefkas.

Vathy, Ithaca

Deep harbour overnight in Homer's island.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Ionian Islands high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at D-Marin Gouvia (Ionian secondary)?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your CFU arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at D-Marin Gouvia (Ionian secondary)?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Ionian Islands.

What does berthing cost at D-Marin Gouvia (Ionian secondary)?

What berthing costs at D-Marin Gouvia (Ionian secondary) depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from D-Marin Gouvia (Ionian secondary)?

Private yacht charter from D-Marin Gouvia (Ionian secondary) is common for Ionian Islands weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at D-Marin Gouvia (Ionian secondary)?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for D-Marin Gouvia (Ionian secondary)?

Typical CFU quay timing: 15-25 min from CFU. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Porto Spilia, Meganisi is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at D-Marin Gouvía (Ionian secondary)?

D-Marin Gouvía (Ionian secondary) typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
