Overview

Serving as the primary Fort-de-France yacht berthing for a Caribbean yacht charter, Fort-de-France yacht berths accommodate vessels up to an indicative maximum LOA of 50 metres. The marina offers 120 berths with a maximum draft of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Fort-de-France yacht berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical FDF quay timing: 15-30 min from FDF. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Fort-de-France yacht berths

Door-to-deck for Fort-de-France: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Fort-de-France yacht berths - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Fort-de-France yacht berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

FDF

Typical FDF quay: 15-30 min from FDF. Typical transfer: 15-30 min from FDF

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Nearby dining

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Fort-de-France yacht berths - book peak weeks ahead.

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights at Fort-de-France yacht berths.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Fort-de-France day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Fort-de-France yacht berths.

Fort-de-France overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Fort-de-France yacht berths is full.

Fort-de-France lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Martinique circuit.

Martinique overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Caribbean.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Fort-de-France high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Fort-de-France yacht berths?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your FDF arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Fort-de-France yacht berths?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Fort-de-France.

What does berthing cost at Fort-de-France yacht berths?

Berthing at Fort-de-France yacht berths is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Fort-de-France yacht berths?

Yes - Fort-de-France yacht berths is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Fort-de-France. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Fort-de-France yacht berths?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Fort-de-France yacht berths?

Typical FDF quay timing: 15-30 min from FDF. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Fort-de-France day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Fort-de-France yacht berths?

Fort-de-France yacht berths typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
