Serving as the primary yacht berthing option in Marie-Galante for Caribbean charters, Grand-Bourg harbour offers 30 berths. The facility accommodates yachts with an indicative maximum length overall of 35 metres and a maximum draft of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Grand-Bourg harbour, Marie-Galante with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical PTP quay timing: Day sail from Guadeloupe. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Grand-Bourg harbour, Marie-Galante

Door-to-deck for Marie-Galante: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Grand-Bourg harbour, Marie-Galante - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Grand-Bourg harbour, Marie-Galante with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

PTP

Typical PTP quay: Day sail from Guadeloupe. Typical transfer: Day sail from Guadeloupe

Weather-aware swim cove on the Guadeloupe circuit.

Marie-Galante quiet hook

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Marie-Galante high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Grand-Bourg harbour, Marie-Galante?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your PTP arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Grand-Bourg harbour, Marie-Galante?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Marie-Galante.

What does berthing cost at Grand-Bourg harbour, Marie-Galante?

Berthing at Grand-Bourg harbour, Marie-Galante is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Grand-Bourg harbour, Marie-Galante?

Yes - Grand-Bourg harbour, Marie-Galante is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Marie-Galante. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Grand-Bourg harbour, Marie-Galante?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Grand-Bourg harbour, Marie-Galante?

Typical PTP quay timing: Day sail from Guadeloupe. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Marie-Galante day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Grand-Bourg harbour, Marie-Galante?

Grand-Bourg harbour, Marie-Galante typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
