Overview

Guadeloupe Hub Berths in the Caribbean provides 40 berths for Guadeloupe Yacht Charter. With an indicative maximum LOA of 50 m and a 4 m maximum draft, it serves as pillar-retained secondary berthing capacity for Guadeloupe ecosystem maps.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Guadeloupe Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical PTP quay timing: 15-25 min from PTP. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

AIRPORT PTP

TYPICAL TRANSFER 15-25 min from PTP

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Guadeloupe Hub Berths

Door-to-deck for Guadeloupe: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Guadeloupe Hub Berths - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Guadeloupe Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

PTP

Typical PTP quay: 15-25 min from PTP. Typical transfer: 15-25 min from PTP

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

SHORE TABLES

Nearby dining

Pointe-à-Pitre Harbour Table

Walk-ashore dining near Marina Bas-du-Fort - book peak weeks ahead.

Les Saintes Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day on the water around Guadeloupe.

Guadeloupe Quay Classic

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights.

Marie-Galante Waterfront

Harbour-view restaurant our captains favour for quay nights.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Pointe-à-Pitre day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Marina Bas-du-Fort.

Guadeloupe overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Caribbean.

Les Saintes lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Guadeloupe circuit.

Marie-Galante quiet hook

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Guadeloupe high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Guadeloupe Hub Berths?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your PTP arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Guadeloupe Hub Berths?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Guadeloupe.

What does berthing cost at Guadeloupe Hub Berths?

Berthing at Guadeloupe Hub Berths is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Guadeloupe Hub Berths?

Yes - Guadeloupe Hub Berths is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Guadeloupe. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Guadeloupe Hub Berths?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Guadeloupe Hub Berths?

Typical PTP quay timing: 15-25 min from PTP. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Pointe-à-Pitre day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Guadeloupe Hub Berths?

Guadeloupe Hub Berths typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
