Located in Asia, Hong Kong Hub Berths offers the Hong Kong Yacht Charter destination 40 berths with an indicative maximum LOA of 50 metres and a 4-metre maximum draught. It provides pillar-retained secondary berthing capacity for Hong Kong ecosystem maps.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Hong Kong Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical HKG quay timing: 25-45 min from HKG. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

AIRPORT HKG

TYPICAL TRANSFER 25-45 min from HKG

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Hong Kong Hub Berths

Door-to-deck for Hong Kong: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Hong Kong Hub Berths - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Hong Kong Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

HKG

Typical HKG quay: 25-45 min from HKG. Typical transfer: 25-45 min from HKG

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

SHORE TABLES

Nearby dining

Victoria Harbour Harbour Table

Walk-ashore dining near RHKYC Kellett Island / harbour berths - book peak weeks ahead.

Aberdeen Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day on the water around Hong Kong.

Hong Kong Quay Classic

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights.

Sai Kung Waterfront

Harbour-view restaurant our captains favour for quay nights.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Victoria Harbour day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near RHKYC Kellett Island / harbour berths.

Hong Kong overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Asia.

Aberdeen lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Hong Kong circuit.

Sai Kung quiet hook

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Hong Kong high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Hong Kong Hub Berths?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your HKG arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Hong Kong Hub Berths?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Hong Kong.

What does berthing cost at Hong Kong Hub Berths?

Hong Kong Hub Berths berth fees move with demand. Blue Ocean Club holds an indicative band for your LOA and dates, then locks the written quote before APA is set for the Hong Kong week.

Is yacht charter available from Hong Kong Hub Berths?

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter both use Hong Kong Hub Berths as a working berth when LOA fits. We match hull class to quay politics and your itinerary.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Hong Kong Hub Berths?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Hong Kong Hub Berths?

Typical HKG quay timing: 25-45 min from HKG. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Victoria Harbour day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Hong Kong Hub Berths?

Hong Kong Hub Berths typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.

ENQUIRE

Begin a conversation.

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
