Serving as the primary Île des Pins yacht berthing in the Pacific, Île des Pins yacht access provides 30 berths for the Île des Pins Yacht Charter destination. It accommodates vessels with an indicative maximum LOA of 40 metres and a maximum draft of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Île des Pins yacht access with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical NOU quay timing: Passage from Nouméa. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Île des Pins yacht access

Door-to-deck for Île des Pins: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Île des Pins yacht access - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Île des Pins yacht access with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

NOU

Typical NOU quay: Passage from Nouméa. Typical transfer: Passage from Nouméa

Weather-aware swim cove on the New Caledonia circuit.

Nouméa day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Port Moselle.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Île des Pins high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Île des Pins yacht access?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your NOU arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Île des Pins yacht access?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Île des Pins.

What does berthing cost at Île des Pins yacht access?

What berthing costs at Île des Pins yacht access depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Île des Pins yacht access?

Private yacht charter from Île des Pins yacht access is common for Île des Pins weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Île des Pins yacht access?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Île des Pins yacht access?

Typical NOU quay timing: Passage from Nouméa. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Île des Pins day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Île des Pins yacht access?

Île des Pins yacht access typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
