Overview

Serving as the primary Pico yacht berthing for Pico Yacht Charter, Madalena harbour in the Atlantic provides 40 berths for visitors. The harbour accommodates vessels with an indicative maximum LOA of 35 metres and a maximum draft of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Madalena harbour, Pico with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical HOR quay timing: Short channel from Horta. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Madalena harbour, Pico

Door-to-deck for Pico: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Madalena harbour, Pico - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Madalena harbour, Pico with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

HOR

Typical HOR quay: Short channel from Horta. Typical transfer: Short channel from Horta

Nearby dining

Pico Harbour Table

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Madalena harbour, Pico - book peak weeks ahead.

Local plates after a day around Pico in the Azores circuit.

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights at Madalena harbour, Pico.

Held table for yacht parties - advance booking in season.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Pico day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Madalena harbour, Pico.

Pico overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Madalena harbour, Pico is full.

Pico lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Azores circuit.

São Miguel day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Marina Ponta Delgada.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Pico high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Madalena harbour, Pico?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your HOR arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Madalena harbour, Pico?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Pico.

What does berthing cost at Madalena harbour, Pico?

What berthing costs at Madalena harbour, Pico depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Madalena harbour, Pico?

Private yacht charter from Madalena harbour, Pico is common for Pico weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Madalena harbour, Pico?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Madalena harbour, Pico?

Typical HOR quay timing: Short channel from Horta. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Pico day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Madalena harbour, Pico?

Madalena harbour, Pico typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
