Overview

Mangaratiba yacht access serves as the primary Mangaratiba yacht berthing for the Mangaratiba Yacht Charter in the Americas. This facility offers 30 berths, accommodating vessels with an indicative maximum LOA of 40 metres and a maximum draught of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Mangaratiba yacht access with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical GIG quay timing: Costa Verde corridor. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Mangaratiba yacht access

Door-to-deck for Mangaratiba: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Mangaratiba yacht access - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Mangaratiba yacht access with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

GIG

Typical GIG quay: Costa Verde corridor. Typical transfer: Costa Verde corridor

Nearby dining

Mangaratiba Harbour Table

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Mangaratiba yacht access - book peak weeks ahead.

Mangaratiba Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day around Mangaratiba in the Brazil Costa Verde circuit.

Mangaratiba yacht access Quay Dining

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights at Mangaratiba yacht access.

Mangaratiba Concierge Table

Held table for yacht parties - advance booking in season.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Mangaratiba day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Mangaratiba yacht access.

Mangaratiba overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Mangaratiba yacht access is full.

Mangaratiba lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Brazil Costa Verde circuit.

Angra dos Reis day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Porto Bracuhy.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Mangaratiba high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Mangaratiba yacht access?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your GIG arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Mangaratiba yacht access?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Mangaratiba.

What does berthing cost at Mangaratiba yacht access?

Berthing at Mangaratiba yacht access is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Mangaratiba yacht access?

Yes - Mangaratiba yacht access is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Mangaratiba. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Mangaratiba yacht access?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Mangaratiba yacht access?

Typical GIG quay timing: Costa Verde corridor. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Mangaratiba day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Mangaratiba yacht access?

Mangaratiba yacht access typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
