Overview

Providing an Alicante city marina corridor for Costa Blanca embarkation, Marina de Alicante and its RCN approaches offer 400 berths in the Mediterranean. For Alicante yacht charter, the facility accepts an indicative maximum LOA of 60 metres and a 4.5 metre maximum draft.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical ALC quay timing: 20-35 min from ALC. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

TYPICAL TRANSFER	20-35 min from ALC

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches

Door-to-deck for Alicante: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

ALC

Typical ALC quay: 20-35 min from ALC. Typical transfer: 20-35 min from ALC

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Cala del Portitxol, Jávea

Iconic rock-island day-hook.

Granadella

Jávea pine cove - early in peak.

Tabarca Island

Marine reserve day from Alicante - rules apply.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Alicante high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your ALC arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Alicante.

What does berthing cost at Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches?

Berthing at Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches?

Yes - Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Alicante. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches?

Typical ALC quay timing: 20-35 min from ALC. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Cala del Portixol, Jávea is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches?

Marina de Alicante / RCN approaches typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
