Serving as a La Paz Sea of Cortez yacht base within the Americas, Marina Costa Baja accommodates charter yachts up to an indicative maximum LOA of 50 metres. This destination for La Paz yacht charters has a maximum draft of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Marina Costa Baja / La Paz with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical LAP quay timing: 20-35 min from LAP. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

AIRPORT	LAP
TYPICAL TRANSFER	20-35 min from LAP

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Marina Costa Baja / La Paz

Door-to-deck for La Paz: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Marina Costa Baja / La Paz - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Marina Costa Baja / La Paz with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

LAP

Typical LAP quay: 20-35 min from LAP. Typical transfer: 20-35 min from LAP

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks La Paz high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Marina Costa Baja / La Paz?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your LAP arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Marina Costa Baja / La Paz?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for La Paz.

What does berthing cost at Marina Costa Baja / La Paz?

What berthing costs at Marina Costa Baja / La Paz depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Marina Costa Baja / La Paz?

Private yacht charter from Marina Costa Baja / La Paz is common for La Paz weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Marina Costa Baja / La Paz?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Marina Costa Baja / La Paz?

Typical LAP quay timing: 20-35 min from LAP. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Balandra is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Marina Costa Baja / La Paz?

Marina Costa Baja / La Paz typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.

ENQUIRE

Begin a conversation.

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
