Overview

Marina Ibiza sits directly opposite Dalt Vila, the UNESCO-listed old town of Ibiza, and is the island's premier superyacht harbour. With 574 berths, a 95m maximum LOA and a private Owners Club, it is the operational base for the Balearic charter season and the natural starting point for a Formentera itinerary.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Town quay density - Formentera day-anchor fallback held before deposit.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 8-16 weeks high season. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical IBZ quay timing: 15-25 min from IBZ. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Marina Ibiza Yacht Berth - Embark Guide

Door-to-deck for Ibiza: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Marina Ibiza - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 8-16 weeks high season. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Town quay density - Formentera day-anchor fallback held before deposit.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

IBZ

Typical IBZ quay: 15-25 min from IBZ. Typical transfer: 15-25 min from IBZ

SHORE TABLES

Nearby dining

Lío Ibiza

Inside Marina Ibiza itself - dinner show with the Old Town as backdrop, book 4 weeks ahead.

Cipriani Downtown Ibiza

Marina Ibiza waterfront - Bellinis and carpaccio, walk from your berth.

Juan y Andrea - Formentera

Tender from Illetes anchorage; book lunch and they collect you from your yacht.

Flanagan's

Palma seafood institution.

Amante Ibiza

Cliff restaurant with yacht tender.

Es Torrent

Ibiza fish shack elevated.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Cala Salada

Pine-clad north-west bay, sheltered from the south, glass-clear water.

Formentera - Illetes

The iconic turquoise sandbank - anchor north of the lighthouse, tender to Juan y Andrea.

Es Vedrà

Drop anchor in the lee of the Es Vedrà rock at sunset - Ibiza's signature photo.

Cala Saladeta

Ibiza west-coast turquoise day-stop.

Espalmador

Formentera sandbar anchorage - holding varies.

Cala Conta roads

Sunset Ibiza classic.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak season is mid-June to mid-September; weekends in August are fully booked with charter turnover. Strong xaloc (SE) wind can make the outer breakwater uncomfortable - request the inner basin if forecast is >25 knots SE. Posidonia seagrass anchoring rules are strictly enforced around Ibiza and Formentera; use the official anchoring app or take a buoy.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

Why plan a Marina Ibiza berth with Blue Ocean Club?

Ibiza town quay - we hold peak slips, anchorage fallbacks and door-to-deck transfers before you fly, with APA line-items before deposit. This is a charter berthing guide, not a marina booking desk.

How do I embark at Marina Ibiza?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your IBZ arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Marina Ibiza?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 8-16 weeks high season Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Ibiza.

What does berthing cost at Marina Ibiza?

Marina Ibiza berth fees move with demand. Blue Ocean Club holds an indicative band for your LOA and dates, then locks the written quote before APA is set for the Ibiza week.

Is yacht charter available from Marina Ibiza?

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter both use Marina Ibiza as a working berth when LOA fits. We match hull class to quay politics and your itinerary.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Marina Ibiza?

8-16 weeks high season

What is the practical embarkation airport for Marina Ibiza?

Typical IBZ quay timing: 15-25 min from IBZ. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Cala Salada is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
