AMERICAS

Overview

Serving as the primary Quepos yacht berthing in the Americas, Marina Pez Vela provides 100 berths for Quepos Yacht Charter. The marina has an indicative maximum LOA of 50 metres and accommodates vessels with a maximum draft of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Marina Pez Vela with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical XQP quay timing: 10-20 min from XQP / 3h from SJO. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Marina Pez Vela

Door-to-deck for Quepos: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Marina Pez Vela - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Marina Pez Vela with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

XQP

Typical XQP quay: 10-20 min from XQP / 3h from SJO. Typical transfer: 10-20 min from XQP / 3h from SJO

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Marina Pez Vela - book peak weeks ahead.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Quepos day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Marina Pez Vela.

Quepos overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Marina Pez Vela is full.

Quepos lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Costa Rica Pacific circuit.

Costa Rica Pacific overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Americas.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Quepos high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Marina Pez Vela?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your XQP arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Marina Pez Vela?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Quepos.

What does berthing cost at Marina Pez Vela?

Berthing at Marina Pez Vela is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Marina Pez Vela?

Yes - Marina Pez Vela is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Quepos. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Marina Pez Vela?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Marina Pez Vela?

Typical XQP quay timing: 10-20 min from XQP / 3h from SJO. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Quepos day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Marina Pez Vela?

Marina Pez Vela typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
