Marina do Porto Santo is the primary Porto Santo yacht berthing destination in the Atlantic. This facility provides 140 berths, accommodating charter yachts with an indicative maximum LOA of 40 metres and a maximum draft of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Marina do Porto Santo with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical PXO quay timing: 10-20 min from PXO. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

TYPICAL TRANSFER	10-20 min from PXO

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Marina do Porto Santo

Door-to-deck for Porto Santo: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Marina do Porto Santo - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Marina do Porto Santo with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

PXO

Typical PXO quay: 10-20 min from PXO. Typical transfer: 10-20 min from PXO

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Nearby dining

Porto Santo Harbour Table

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Marina do Porto Santo - book peak weeks ahead.

Porto Santo Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day around Porto Santo in the Madeira circuit.

Marina do Porto Santo Quay Dining

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights at Marina do Porto Santo.

Funchal Harbour Table

Walk-ashore dining near Marina do Funchal - book peak weeks ahead.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Porto Santo day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Marina do Porto Santo.

Porto Santo overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Marina do Porto Santo is full.

Porto Santo lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Madeira circuit.

Funchal day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Marina do Funchal.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Porto Santo high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Marina do Porto Santo?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your PXO arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Marina do Porto Santo?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Porto Santo.

What does berthing cost at Marina do Porto Santo?

Berthing at Marina do Porto Santo is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Marina do Porto Santo?

Yes - Marina do Porto Santo is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Porto Santo. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Marina do Porto Santo?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Marina do Porto Santo?

Typical PXO quay timing: 10-20 min from PXO. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Porto Santo day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Marina do Porto Santo?

Marina do Porto Santo typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.

ENQUIRE

Begin a conversation.

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
