PACIFIC

Overview

Marina Vaitape is the main village marina inside the lagoon of Bora Bora. It offers an indicative maximum LOA of 40 metres and a 3.5-metre draft. As lagoon anchoring is regulated to protect the coral, moorings should be arranged in advance for this Pacific destination.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Marina Vaitape, Bora Bora with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical BOB quay timing: 10-20 min from BOB. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

TYPICAL TRANSFER	10-20 min from BOB

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Marina Vaitape, Bora Bora

Door-to-deck for Bora Bora: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Marina Vaitape, Bora Bora - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Marina Vaitape, Bora Bora with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

BOB

Typical BOB quay: 10-20 min from BOB. Typical transfer: 10-20 min from BOB

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Marina Vaitape, Bora Bora?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your BOB arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Marina Vaitape, Bora Bora?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Bora Bora.

What does berthing cost at Marina Vaitape, Bora Bora?

Berthing at Marina Vaitape, Bora Bora is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Marina Vaitape, Bora Bora?

Yes - Marina Vaitape, Bora Bora is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Bora Bora. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Marina Vaitape, Bora Bora?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Marina Vaitape, Bora Bora?

Typical BOB quay timing: 10-20 min from BOB. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

East lagoon motus is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Marina Vaitape, Bora Bora?

Marina Vaitape, Bora Bora typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
