Overview

Mykonos New Port - known locally as Tourlos - is the superyacht stern-to harbour 2km north of Mykonos Town. With 120 berths and capacity for yachts up to 100m, it is the operational base for Cyclades charters and the closest deep-water berth to Nammos, Scorpios and the island's beach club circuit.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Mykonos New Port (Tourlos) with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Confirm fuel, shore power amp rating and waste before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths around Mykonos New Port (Tourlos) typically need 4-12 weeks for larger LOA. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Primary gateway ATH. We choreograph chauffeur or helicopter into the gangway window.

AIRPORT ATH

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Mykonos New Port (Tourlos)

Door-to-deck for Greece: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Mykonos New Port (Tourlos) - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths around Mykonos New Port (Tourlos) typically need 4-12 weeks for larger LOA. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Mykonos New Port (Tourlos) with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Confirm fuel, shore power amp rating and waste before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

ATH

Primary gateway ATH.

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

SHORE TABLES

Nearby dining

Nammos - Psarou Beach

Tender from Psarou anchorage; reserve a front-row table 3+ weeks ahead in August.

Scorpios

Paraga peninsula - anchor outside, tender in for sunset DJ sets and dinner.

Kiku - Mykonos Town

Walk from the tender dock into Little Venice; the omakase is the island's best sushi.

Hippie Fish

Beachfront Mykonos lunch - book yacht tables early.

Nobu Mykonos

Destination dinner night ashore.

Kodylenia's Taverna

Harbour classic overlooking the fleet.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Ornos Bay

South-coast sandy bay, sheltered from the meltemi, tender ashore to Nammos beach club.

Super Paradise

The classic Mykonos party beach anchorage - afternoons only, exposed after sunset.

Rineia Island

Uninhabited island between Mykonos and Delos - turquoise coves, zero crowds, perfect lunch escape.

Delos

Anchor off the archaeological site (day only) and tender ashore for the ancient ruins.

Kolona, Kythnos

Double-bay thermal anchorage - classic Cyclades overnight.

Kini Bay, Syros

Quiet alternative to Ermoupoli quay nights.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Meltemi (N/NW wind) blows hard July-August, regularly 30+ knots - Tourlos is exposed to the north and can become untenable. South-coast anchorages (Ornos, Psarou, Paradise) are the meltemi refuge. Most superyachts use Tourlos for crew/provisioning and overnight on the south coast or at Rineia.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Mykonos New Port (Tourlos)?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your ATH arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Mykonos New Port (Tourlos)?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. For peak season and event weeks, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger LOA; shoulder season is more flexible. Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Greece.

What does berthing cost at Mykonos New Port (Tourlos)?

What berthing costs at Mykonos New Port (Tourlos) depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Mykonos New Port (Tourlos)?

Private yacht charter from Mykonos New Port (Tourlos) is common for Greece weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Mykonos New Port (Tourlos)?

For peak season and event weeks, 4-12 weeks is typical for larger LOA; shoulder season is more flexible. We start the berth conversation when the yacht shortlist is open.

What is the practical embarkation airport for Mykonos New Port (Tourlos)?

Primary gateway ATH. We choreograph chauffeur or helicopter into the gangway window.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Ornos Bay is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Mykonos New Port (Tourlos)?

We confirm fuel, shore power, water and waste against your LOA with the marina agent before contract.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
