Overview

Old Port Mykonos approaches - An entry to Mediterranean Cyclades yacht charters, the historic Mykonos town approaches at the Old Port offer a sheltered harbour basin with 200 berths. It has a 4.5-metre draft and an indicative 40-metre LOA limit; Tourlos is preferred for larger vessels, with the pillar secondary.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Old Port Mykonos approaches with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical JMK quay timing: 10-20 min from JMK. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

AIRPORT JMK

TYPICAL TRANSFER 10-20 min from JMK

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Old Port Mykonos approaches

Door-to-deck for Cyclades: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Old Port Mykonos approaches - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Old Port Mykonos approaches with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

JMK

Typical JMK quay: 10-20 min from JMK. Typical transfer: 10-20 min from JMK

Nearby dining

Siparos

Harbour-view seafood - book peak Meltemi weeks ahead.

Mario

Classic Cycladic grill steps from the quay.

Medusa

Cave-side lobster and octopus after a Kleftiko day.

Drakos Taverna

Gialos waterfront plates for embarkation nights.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Antiparos south bays

Clear-water day-hooks opposite Paros - arrive early in July.

Kleftiko, Milos

Iconic sea-cave day stop - weather window only; no overnight assumption.

Mylopotas, Ios

Sand beach day-anchor when Gialos is dense.

Plaka / Agia Anna, Naxos

West-coast swim corridor near town.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Cyclades high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Old Port Mykonos approaches?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your JMK arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Old Port Mykonos approaches?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Cyclades.

What does berthing cost at Old Port Mykonos approaches?

Berthing at Old Port Mykonos approaches is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Old Port Mykonos approaches?

Yes - Old Port Mykonos approaches is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Cyclades. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Old Port Mykonos approaches?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Old Port Mykonos approaches?

Typical JMK quay timing: 10-20 min from JMK. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Antiparos south bays is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Old Port Mykonos approaches?

Old Port Mykonos approaches typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
