Opua Marina, Bay of Islands - Serving as the primary yacht hub for Bay of Islands yacht charters in the Pacific region, Opua Marina accommodates vessels with a maximum draft of 4 metres. The marina accepts yachts with an indicative maximum length overall of 50 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Opua Marina, Bay of Islands with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical AKL quay timing: 3 hrs drive / regional flight. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

AIRPORT AKL

TYPICAL TRANSFER 3 hrs drive / regional flight

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Opuia Marina, Bay of Islands

Door-to-deck for Bay of Islands: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Opuia Marina, Bay of Islands - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Opuia Marina, Bay of Islands with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

AKL

Typical AKL quay: 3 hrs drive / regional flight. Typical transfer: 3 hrs drive / regional flight

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Bay of Islands high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Opuia Marina, Bay of Islands?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your AKL arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Opuia Marina, Bay of Islands?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Bay of Islands.

What does berthing cost at Opuia Marina, Bay of Islands?

Opuia Marina, Bay of Islands berth fees move with demand. Blue Ocean Club holds an indicative band for your LOA and dates, then locks the written quote before APA is set for the Bay of Islands week.

Is yacht charter available from Opuia Marina, Bay of Islands?

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter both use Opuia Marina, Bay of Islands as a working berth when LOA fits. We match hull class to quay politics and your itinerary.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Opuia Marina, Bay of Islands?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Opuia Marina, Bay of Islands?

Typical AKL quay timing: 3 hrs drive / regional flight. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Ururupukapuka - Otehei Bay is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Opuā Marina, Bay of Islands?

Opuā Marina, Bay of Islands typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.

ENQUIRE

Begin a conversation.

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
