Overview

Located in the Caribbean, the Panama San Blas Hub Berths offer 40 berths for Panama San Blas yacht charters. The site has an indicative maximum LOA of 40 metres and a 4-metre draft, featuring pillar-retained secondary berthing capacity for Panama San Blas ecosystem maps.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Panama San Blas Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical PTY quay timing: Air / yacht run from Shelter Bay. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

AIRPORT PTY

TYPICAL TRANSFER Air / yacht run from Shelter Bay

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Panama San Blas Hub Berths

Door-to-deck for Panama San Blas: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Panama San Blas Hub Berths - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Panama San Blas Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

PTY

Typical PTY quay: Air / yacht run from Shelter Bay. Typical transfer: Air / yacht run from Shelter Bay

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

SHORE TABLES

Nearby dining

San Blas Harbour Table

Walk-ashore dining near San Blas / Guna Yala mooring fields - book peak weeks ahead.

Colón Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day on the water around Panama San Blas.

Panama San Blas Quay Classic

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights.

Bocas del Toro Waterfront

Harbour-view restaurant our captains favour for quay nights.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

San Blas day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near San Blas / Guna Yala mooring fields.

Panama San Blas overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Caribbean.

Colón lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Panama San Blas circuit.

Bocas del Toro quiet hook

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Panama San Blas high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Panama San Blas Hub Berths?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your PTY arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Panama San Blas Hub Berths?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Panama San Blas.

What does berthing cost at Panama San Blas Hub Berths?

Berthing at Panama San Blas Hub Berths is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Panama San Blas Hub Berths?

Yes - Panama San Blas Hub Berths is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Panama San Blas. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Panama San Blas Hub Berths?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Panama San Blas Hub Berths?

Typical PTY quay timing: Air / yacht run from Shelter Bay. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

San Blas day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Panama San Blas Hub Berths?

Panama San Blas Hub Berths typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
