Located in the Caribbean for a Gustavia Yacht Charter, Port de Gustavia accommodates vessels up to 80 metres in length with a maximum draft of 5 metres. This iconic St Barths harbour experiences a high density of megayacht Med-mooring during the season.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Harbour control mandatory in peak; outer anchorage + tender is the megayacht default when quay is unavailable.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 6-12 months for New Year / peak holidays. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical SBH quay timing: 10-20 min from SBH. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Port de Gustavia Yacht Berth - Embark Guide

Door-to-deck for Gustavia: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Port de Gustavia - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 6-12 months for New Year / peak holidays. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Harbour control mandatory in peak; outer anchorage + tender is the megayacht default when quay is unavailable.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

SBH

Typical SBH quay: 10-20 min from SBH. Typical transfer: 10-20 min from SBH

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Gustavia high season and local events - 6-12 months for New Year / peak holidays lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

Why plan a Port de Gustavia berth with Blue Ocean Club?

Gustavia peak-week berths - we hold peak slips, anchorage fallbacks and door-to-deck transfers before you fly, with APA line-items before deposit. This is a charter berthing guide, not a marina booking desk.

How do I embark at Port de Gustavia?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your SBH arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Port de Gustavia?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 6-12 months for New Year / peak holidays Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Gustavia.

What does berthing cost at Port de Gustavia?

Port de Gustavia berth fees move with demand. Blue Ocean Club holds an indicative band for your LOA and dates, then locks the written quote before APA is set for the Gustavia week.

Is yacht charter available from Port de Gustavia?

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter both use Port de Gustavia as a working berth when LOA fits. We match hull class to quay politics and your itinerary.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Port de Gustavia?

6-12 months for New Year / peak holidays

What is the practical embarkation airport for Port de Gustavia?

Typical SBH quay timing: 10-20 min from SBH. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Colombier is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.

ENQUIRE

Begin a conversation.

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
