Overview

Port Louis Marina in Grenada serves as the primary embarkation point for a St George's yacht charter in the Caribbean. This megayacht marina accommodates vessels with an indicative maximum LOA of 100 metres and a maximum draft of 6 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Port Louis Marina, Grenada with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical GND quay timing: 15-25 min from GND. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Port Louis Marina, Grenada Yacht Berth - Embark Guide

Door-to-deck for St George's: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Port Louis Marina, Grenada - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Port Louis Marina, Grenada with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

GND

Typical GND quay: 15-25 min from GND. Typical transfer: 15-25 min from GND

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks St George's high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**Why plan a Port Louis Marina, Grenada berth with Blue Ocean Club?**

Grenada megayacht berth - we hold peak slips, anchorage fallbacks and door-to-deck transfers before you fly, with APA line-items before deposit. This is a charter berthing guide, not a marina booking desk.

How do I embark at Port Louis Marina, Grenada?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your GND arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Port Louis Marina, Grenada?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for St George's.

What does berthing cost at Port Louis Marina, Grenada?

Berthing at Port Louis Marina, Grenada is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Port Louis Marina, Grenada?

Yes - Port Louis Marina, Grenada is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in St George's. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Port Louis Marina, Grenada?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Port Louis Marina, Grenada?

Typical GND quay timing: 15-25 min from GND. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Grand Anse is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
