Overview

Porto di Santa Margherita Ligure in the Mediterranean offers a practical Ligurian berth near Portofino by tender or train. For a Santa Margherita Yacht Charter, it accommodates vessels up to an indicative 50 metres (indicative) LOA with a maximum draft of 4.5 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Porto di Santa Margherita Ligure with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical GOA quay timing: 55-80 min from GOA. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Porto di Santa Margherita Ligure Yacht Berth - Embark Guide

Door-to-deck for Santa Margherita: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Porto di Santa Margherita Ligure - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Porto di Santa Margherita Ligure with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

GOA

Typical GOA quay: 55-80 min from GOA. Typical transfer: 55-80 min from GOA

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Santa Margherita high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**Why plan a Porto di Santa Margherita Ligure berth with Blue Ocean Club?**

Portofino overflow quay - we hold peak slips, anchorage fallbacks and door-to-deck transfers before you fly, with APA line-items before deposit. This is a charter berthing guide, not a marina booking desk.

How do I embark at Porto di Santa Margherita Ligure?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your GOA arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Porto di Santa Margherita Ligure?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Santa Margherita.

What does berthing cost at Porto di Santa Margherita Ligure?

What berthing costs at Porto di Santa Margherita Ligure depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Porto di Santa Margherita Ligure?

Private yacht charter from Porto di Santa Margherita Ligure is common for Santa Margherita weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Porto di Santa Margherita Ligure?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Porto di Santa Margherita Ligure?

Typical GOA quay timing: 55-80 min from GOA. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Santa Margherita roadstead is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
