## PILOTAGE NOTES

## Approach

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Approach Puerto Banús with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

## HOLDS &amp; LEAD TIMES

## Berthing

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Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

## TRANSFERS

## Door to deck

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Typical AGP quay timing: 45-60 min from AGP. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

## EMBARK UTILITY

## Embark at Puerto Banús

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Door-to-deck for Puerto Banús: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

| <b>MEETING POINT</b>  | Meeting point: Puerto Banús - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.                                           |
| <b>ARRIVAL BUFFER</b> | Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed. |

### Captain notes

Approach Puerto Banús with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

### Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

### Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

### AGP

Typical AGP quay: 45-60 min from AGP. Typical transfer: 45-60 min from AGP

## **Seasonal note**

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Peak density tracks Puerto Banús high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

## **Berth fees**

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Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

#### **BEFORE YOU FLY**

## **Berthing FAQ**

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### **How do I embark at Puerto Banús?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your AGP arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

### **Can I berth a yacht at Puerto Banús?**

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Puerto Banús.

### **What does berthing cost at Puerto Banús?**

Puerto Banús berth fees move with demand. Blue Ocean Club holds an indicative band for your LOA and dates, then locks the written quote before APA is set for the Puerto Banús week.

### **Is yacht charter available from Puerto Banús?**

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter both use Puerto Banús as a working berth when LOA fits. We match hull class to quay politics and your itinerary.

### **How far ahead should we book a berth at Puerto Banús?**

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

### **What is the practical embarkation airport for Puerto Banús?**

Typical AGP quay timing: 45-60 min from AGP. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

### **Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?**

Banús outer holding is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.





### What services should we expect at Puerto Banús?

Puerto Banús typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

*Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.*
