Serving as the primary Puerto Princesa yacht berthing option in Asia, Puerto Princesa yacht berths offer 50 berths for a Puerto Princesa Yacht Charter. The marina accommodates vessels with an indicative maximum LOA of 45 metres and a maximum draft of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Puerto Princesa yacht berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical PPS quay timing: 15-30 min from PPS. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

TYPICAL TRANSFER	15-30 min from PPS

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Puerto Princesa yacht berths

Door-to-deck for Puerto Princesa: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Puerto Princesa yacht berths - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Puerto Princesa yacht berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

PPS

Typical PPS quay: 15-30 min from PPS. Typical transfer: 15-30 min from PPS

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Nearby dining

Puerto Princesa Harbour Table

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Puerto Princesa yacht berths - book peak weeks ahead.

Puerto Princesa Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day around Puerto Princesa in the Palawan circuit.

Puerto Princesa yacht berths Quay Dining

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights at Puerto Princesa yacht berths.

Puerto Princesa Waterfront

Harbour-view restaurant our captains favour for quay nights.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Puerto Princesa day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Puerto Princesa yacht berths.

Puerto Princesa overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Puerto Princesa yacht berths is full.

Puerto Princesa lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Palawan circuit.

Puerto Princesa quiet hook

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Puerto Princesa high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Puerto Princesa yacht berths?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your PPS arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Puerto Princesa yacht berths?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Puerto Princesa.

What does berthing cost at Puerto Princesa yacht berths?

Berthing at Puerto Princesa yacht berths is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Puerto Princesa yacht berths?

Yes - Puerto Princesa yacht berths is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Puerto Princesa. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Puerto Princesa yacht berths?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Puerto Princesa yacht berths?

Typical PPS quay timing: 15-30 min from PPS. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Puerto Princesa day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Puerto Princesa yacht berths?

Puerto Princesa yacht berths typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
