Located on the Costa del Sol in the Mediterranean, Puerto Sotogrande is an upscale marina situated between Marbella and Gibraltar. It accommodates yachts with an indicative maximum length overall of 70 metres and a maximum draft of 5.5 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Puerto Sotogrande with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical AGP quay timing: 70-90 min from AGP. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

AIRPORT AGP

TYPICAL TRANSFER 70-90 min from AGP

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Puerto Sotogrande

Door-to-deck for Costa del Sol: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Puerto Sotogrande - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Puerto Sotogrande with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

AGP

Typical AGP quay: 70-90 min from AGP. Typical transfer: 70-90 min from AGP

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Costa del Sol high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Puerto Sotogrande?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your AGP arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Puerto Sotogrande?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Costa del Sol.

What does berthing cost at Puerto Sotogrande?

Puerto Sotogrande berth fees move with demand. Blue Ocean Club holds an indicative band for your LOA and dates, then locks the written quote before APA is set for the Costa del Sol week.

Is yacht charter available from Puerto Sotogrande?

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter both use Puerto Sotogrande as a working berth when LOA fits. We match hull class to quay politics and your itinerary.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Puerto Sotogrande?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Puerto Sotogrande?

Typical AGP quay timing: 70-90 min from AGP. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Cabopino dunes is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Puerto Sotogrande?

Puerto Sotogrande typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.

ENQUIRE

Begin a conversation.

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
