Reef Island yacht access is the primary Reef Island yacht berthing in the Middle East region. Serving Reef Island Yacht Charter, this destination offers 40 berths with an indicative maximum LOA of 40 metres and a maximum draft of 4 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Reef Island yacht access with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical BAH quay timing: 25-40 min from BAH. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Reef Island yacht access

Door-to-deck for Reef Island: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Reef Island yacht access - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Reef Island yacht access with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

BAH

Typical BAH quay: 25-40 min from BAH. Typical transfer: 25-40 min from BAH

Nearby dining

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Reef Island yacht access - book peak weeks ahead.

Walk-ashore dining near Bahrain Yacht Club - book peak weeks ahead.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Reef Island day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Reef Island yacht access.

Reef Island overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Reef Island yacht access is full.

Reef Island lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Bahrain circuit.

Manama day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Bahrain Yacht Club.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Reef Island high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Reef Island yacht access?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your BAH arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Reef Island yacht access?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Reef Island.

What does berthing cost at Reef Island yacht access?

Reef Island yacht access berth fees move with demand. Blue Ocean Club holds an indicative band for your LOA and dates, then locks the written quote before APA is set for the Reef Island week.

Is yacht charter available from Reef Island yacht access?

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter both use Reef Island yacht access as a working berth when LOA fits. We match hull class to quay politics and your itinerary.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Reef Island yacht access?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Reef Island yacht access?

Typical BAH quay timing: 25-40 min from BAH. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Reef Island day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Reef Island yacht access?

Reef Island yacht access typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
