PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Royal Yacht Club of Jordan with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical AQJ quay timing: 15-25 min from AQJ. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

TYPICAL TRANSFER	15-25 min from AQJ

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Royal Yacht Club of Jordan

Door-to-deck for Aqaba: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Royal Yacht Club of Jordan - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Royal Yacht Club of Jordan with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

AQJ

Typical AQJ quay: 15-25 min from AQJ. Typical transfer: 15-25 min from AQJ

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

SHORE TABLES

Nearby dining

Aqaba Harbour Table

Walk-ashore or tender dining near Royal Yacht Club of Jordan - book peak weeks ahead.

Aqaba Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day around Aqaba in the Aqaba circuit.

Royal Yacht Club of Jordan Quay Dining

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights at Royal Yacht Club of Jordan.

Tala Bay Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day on the water around Aqaba.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Protected day-stop captains favour near Royal Yacht Club of Jordan.

Aqaba overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when Royal Yacht Club of Jordan is full.

Aqaba lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Aqaba circuit.

Tala Bay lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Aqaba circuit.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Aqaba high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Royal Yacht Club of Jordan?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your AQJ arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Royal Yacht Club of Jordan?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Aqaba.

What does berthing cost at Royal Yacht Club of Jordan?

What berthing costs at Royal Yacht Club of Jordan depends on length overall, peak weeks and power amp rating. Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

Is yacht charter available from Royal Yacht Club of Jordan?

Private yacht charter from Royal Yacht Club of Jordan is common for Aqaba weeks. Captains confirm approach and tender logistics; we hold the quay or an anchorage fallback.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Royal Yacht Club of Jordan?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Royal Yacht Club of Jordan?

Typical AQJ quay timing: 15-25 min from AQJ. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Aqaba day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Royal Yacht Club of Jordan?

Royal Yacht Club of Jordan typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
