PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Saudi Red Sea Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical JED quay timing: 25-45 min from JED. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

AIRPORT JED

TYPICAL TRANSFER 25-45 min from JED

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Saudi Red Sea Hub Berths

Door-to-deck for Saudi Red Sea: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Saudi Red Sea Hub Berths - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Saudi Red Sea Hub Berths with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

JED

Typical JED quay: 25-45 min from JED. Typical transfer: 25-45 min from JED

[Draft] Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

SHORE TABLES

Nearby dining

Jeddah Harbour Table

Walk-ashore dining near Jeddah Yacht Club - book peak weeks ahead.

NEOM / Amaala Shore Kitchen

Local plates after a day on the water around Saudi Red Sea.

Saudi Red Sea Quay Classic

Marina-adjacent dining for embarkation nights.

Yanbu Waterfront

Harbour-view restaurant our captains favour for quay nights.

FALLBACKS

Nearby anchorages

Jeddah day anchorage

Protected day-stop captains favour near Jeddah Yacht Club.

Saudi Red Sea overnight roadstead

Deeper holding when primary quays are full in Red Sea.

NEOM / Amaala lee cove

Weather-aware swim cove on the Saudi Red Sea circuit.

Yanbu quiet hook

Lower-density day-hook for privacy mornings.

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Saudi Red Sea high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Saudi Red Sea Hub Berths?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your JED arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Saudi Red Sea Hub Berths?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Saudi Red Sea.

What does berthing cost at Saudi Red Sea Hub Berths?

Berthing at Saudi Red Sea Hub Berths is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Saudi Red Sea Hub Berths?

Yes - Saudi Red Sea Hub Berths is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in Saudi Red Sea. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Saudi Red Sea Hub Berths?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Saudi Red Sea Hub Berths?

Typical JED quay timing: 25-45 min from JED. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Jeddah day anchorage is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Saudi Red Sea Hub Berths?

Saudi Red Sea Hub Berths typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.

ENQUIRE

Begin a conversation.

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
