The Anse des Cayes and St Jean tender access in the Caribbean serves the St Jean Yacht Charter destination. It accommodates an indicative maximum LOA of 40 metres with a 3.5-metre draft. This St Jean beach-club tender zone features limited docks.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Anse des Cayes / St Jean tender access with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical SBH quay timing: 10 min from SBH. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

TYPICAL TRANSFER	10 min from SBH

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Anse des Cayes / St Jean tender access

Door-to-deck for St Jean: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Anse des Cayes / St Jean tender access - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Anse des Cayes / St Jean tender access with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

SBH

Typical SBH quay: 10 min from SBH. Typical transfer: 10 min from SBH

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks St Jean high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ

How do I embark at Anse des Cayes / St Jean tender access?

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your SBH arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Anse des Cayes / St Jean tender access?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for St Jean.

What does berthing cost at Anse des Cayes / St Jean tender access?

Berthing at Anse des Cayes / St Jean tender access is quoted by LOA, season and events - we share indicative ranges labelled as draft, then confirm in writing before deposit. Never treat a published nightly figure as a hard fact.

Is yacht charter available from Anse des Cayes / St Jean tender access?

Yes - Anse des Cayes / St Jean tender access is a practical embarkation for crewed yacht charter in St Jean. We sequence the berth, transfers and first-night plan before you fly.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Anse des Cayes / St Jean tender access?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Anse des Cayes / St Jean tender access?

Typical SBH quay timing: 10 min from SBH. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

St Jean Bay is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Anse des Cayes / St Jean tender access?

Anse des Cayes / St Jean tender access typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.
