Overview

Located in the Pacific, Viaduct Harbour in Auckland is a yacht charter destination featuring city-edge berths for larger LOA events. The marina accommodates vessels with an indicative maximum LOA of 60 metres and a maximum draft of 4.5 metres.

PILOTAGE NOTES

Approach

Approach Pier 21 / Viaduct Auckland with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

HOLDS & LEAD TIMES

Berthing

Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

TRANSFERS

Door to deck

Typical AKL quay timing: 25-40 min from AKL. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

AIRPORT **AKL**

TYPICAL TRANSFER **25-40 min from AKL**

EMBARK UTILITY

Embark at Pier 21 / Viaduct Auckland

Door-to-deck for Auckland: fly into the gateway, transfer timed to the gangway, luggage aboard before guests. We choreograph the buffer - not a taxi scramble.

MEETING POINT	Meeting point: Pier 21 / Viaduct Auckland - confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation.
ARRIVAL BUFFER	Plan 60-90 minutes from wheels-down to passerelle for chauffeur corridors; helicopter windows are tighter when helipad access is confirmed.
PEAK LEAD TIME	Peak berths typically need 4-12 weeks for peak season slips. We hold anchorage fallbacks before you fly.

Captain notes

Approach Pier 21 / Viaduct Auckland with local pilotage notes from the captain; high season berths book weeks ahead. Fuel, water and shore power are available - confirm waste and amp rating before arrival.

Tender fallback

When berths are scarce we hold a sheltered anchorage + tender (or captain-only standby) plan before you fly - never a last-minute scramble at the mole.

Luggage / hotel

Night-before hotel near the gateway (or marina) when late arrivals risk missing the embarkation slot - we hold rooms against the transfer plan.

AKL

Typical AKL quay: 25-40 min from AKL. Typical transfer: 25-40 min from AKL

TIMING

Seasonal note

Peak density tracks Auckland high season and local events - 4-12 weeks for peak season slips lead time is typical for larger LOA.

INDICATIVE DRAFT

Berth fees

Indicative seasonal berth ranges are shared on request - confirm with the marina agent before contract. We never publish unverified nightly rates as fact.

BEFORE YOU FLY

Berthing FAQ**How do I embark at Viaduct Harbour, Auckland?**

Confirm quay / pontoon with the captain the morning of embarkation after your AKL arrival. We brief the chauffeur on the correct marina gate - not a generic harbour drop.

Can I berth a yacht at Viaduct Harbour, Auckland?

Yes when LOA, draft and event weeks allow. 4-12 weeks for peak season slips Blue Ocean Club opens the berth conversation with the yacht shortlist for Auckland.

What does berthing cost at Viaduct Harbour, Auckland?

Viaduct Harbour, Auckland berth fees move with demand. Blue Ocean Club holds an indicative band for your LOA and dates, then locks the written quote before APA is set for the Auckland week.

Is yacht charter available from Viaduct Harbour, Auckland?

Boat charter and crewed yacht charter both use Viaduct Harbour, Auckland as a working berth when LOA fits. We match hull class to quay politics and your itinerary.

How far ahead should we book a berth at Viaduct Harbour, Auckland?

4-12 weeks for peak season slips

What is the practical embarkation airport for Viaduct Harbour, Auckland?

Typical AKL quay timing: 25-40 min from AKL. Timed to embarkation, not a taxi scramble.

Can we overnight at anchor instead of taking a quay night?

Waiheke - Oneroa approaches is a common alternative when the quay is full - captains confirm holding and shelter before committing.

What services should we expect at Viaduct Harbour, Auckland?

Viaduct Harbour, Auckland typically offers fuel, shore power, water, waste/pump-out, harbour Wi-Fi. Confirm amp rating and pump-out against your LOA before arrival.

Indicative guidance - some berth fee notes are labelled draft. Live rates move with LOA, season and events. Blue Ocean Club confirms in writing before deposit. No invented phone numbers or reviews. Not a substitute for captain pilotage or marina contracts.

ENQUIRE

Begin a conversation.

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
